RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Duration of matches will be decided by Technical Committee depend upon registration of Teams.
- 2. Only First eight Teams registration will be confirmed.
- 3. Only one team shall be allowed from each school / club in each age group. The Competition is open only to bona fide students of the school / club.
- 4. Each Team shall comprise of not more than 12 players plus a Coach & Manager.
- 5. If any team is not ready to play within 10 minutes of the scheduled time, the opponent shall be awarded walkover.
- 6. Matches will be held subject to a minimum of Eight teams in each category
- 7. Any replacement or substitution of registered players may be allowed before the team plays its first match. Any replacement or addition (if less player registered) of registered players may be allowed subject to request letter from the Principal on official school letterhead or Club secretary. No replacement will be allowed thereafter, even if it be a case of injury, sickness or any other cause.
- 8. Players can play in only one team and one age group during the tournament. A junior player can play in senior age group, but he cannot then play in the junior age group to which he belongs.
- 9. If team fails to enter the field even after the referee has blown the whistle, he is authorized to caution the captain of the defaulting team, for unsporting behavior.
- 10. Teams shall turn out in uniform color i.e. Jersey and shoes compulsory. The goalkeeper must have a contrasting color. Each jersey must have a number which should be clearly visible on the back. Referee may debar any player who is not in a proper dress code as mentioned above.
- 11. Duration 15 minutes each half with 3 minutes interval respectively.
- 12. In the event of a draw, No extra time will be allotted and tie breaker / sudden death rules will be applied.
- 13. The matches will be played as per the rules of the Intl Handball Federation.
